ABOUT THE FILM

Food For Profit is the first feature documentary that exposes the links between the meat industry, lobbying, and the corridors of power. It denounces how Europe is transferring hundreds of billions of taxpayers' money into the hands of intensive farms, which mistreat animals, pollute the environment, and pose a potential danger for future pandemics. With a cinematic approach for an investigative documentary, Giulia Innocenzi and Pablo D'Ambrosi take us on an enlightening but shocking journey across Europe, where they confront farmers, corporations, and politicians. Their team of investigators infiltrated farms in many European countries, exposing the truth behind the perceived excellence of European dairy and meat production. In parallel, a lobbyist has infiltrated the high spheres of power in Brussels, gaining shocking information.





BEHIND THE FILM

GIULIA INNOCENZI (DIRECTOR) is a prime time Italian TV host and journalist also known for her investigations into factory farms. She currently works for the investigative TV program Report broadcast on national public TV Rai. She targeted big brands like Parma ham and Fileni, the first Italian organic poultry producer, and recently she managed to get into the 26 storey pig hotel in China, an undercover investigation that was picked up by many international media outlets. 'Tritacarne', her book about the meat and dairy industry, has become a bestseller.

PABLO D'AMBROSI (DIRECTOR) is a British-Italian filmmaker and has been involved in feature documentaries since 2008. He has been working on music documentaries for artists such as The Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, Adele, The Clash, just to mention a few. He also has an extensive knowledge of secret filming and investigative documentaries, having worked for the prestigious BBC programs Panorama and This World, which won the Prix Europa for best Current Affairs Documentary.


JONATHAN REYES (ANIMATOR) is a US Emmy winning designer, director, and animator. Former executive Creative Director at CNN Digital.

ALESSANDRO GIOVANETTO (MUSIC COMPOSER) is an Italian film composer, producer, and guitarist who graduated from both the "Institute of Contemporary Music Performance" and the "Royal College of Music" in London, majoring in Guitar Performance and Composition for Screen. As an arranger, composer and guitarist, Alessandro has collaborated with various European artists, contributing to the creation of four albums. In his role as a composer for the screen, Alessandro has written soundtracks spanning animation, live-action, theatrical plays, and video games.

THE INVESTIGATIONS

LAV, the animal rights association since 1977, has coordinated the undercover investigations in farms all over Europe.

LORENZO MINEO investigated the link between the meat industry, lobbying, and the corridors of power at the European Parliament. He also coordinates the Brussels office of Eumans - Citizens for democracy and sustainability, a pan-European movement based on popular initiative, which promotes campaigns on human rights and sustainability.
